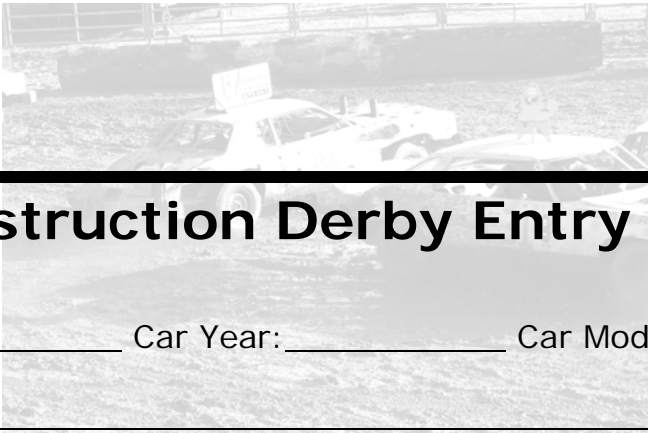

## Vehicle & Derby Rules

1. No Imperials, pickup trucks or 4-wheel drives will be allowed to participate in the derby/powder puff.
2. Officials may cut and drill frames prior to Derby at the time of inspections. Officials reserve the right to disqualify any entry for any rule violation.
3. Protests must be filed in writing within 24 hours of the event and require a \$50.00 filing fee.
4. **Vehicles must be loaded prior to any pay-off being presented. Contestants must not leave the premises of the derby with an empty trailer. Security will strictly enforce this rule.**
5. All glass and chrome strips shall be removed from the car before entry to the fairground.
6. Doors must be chained or welded shut securely. All doors may be welded shut. All chains on vehicle must be at least a minimum quarter inch ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ) chain or a maximum half inch ( $\frac{1}{2}$ " ) chain. Chains may not exceed three feet (3') anywhere on vehicle.
7. Trunks must be opened for inspection unless they are welded shut. If welded shut there shall be an eight inch (8") hole in the trunk lid to allow for inspection. If trunk lid is welded or bolted, it must be two inch (2"), skip six inch (6"), and welded or bolted two inches (2") around the entire lid. If lid is chained a maximum of four (4) chains may be used. Chain must go thru the bumper and be bolted or welded to the trunk. (mandatory) 2 chains in back and 2 chains in the front.
8. Bumpers must be chained with no more than two chains on front or rear bumper. Bumper chains can not go thru or be connected to the frame.
9. Trunk lids may be welded, chained or bolted. No combinations. Maximum bolt one inch (1") in diameter, maximum washer three inches (3") in diameter, all washers no more than quarter inch ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ) thick. Bolts may not be welded.
10. Hoods are to be chained or bolted with a maximum of four (4) one inch (1") bolts, all washers maximum of quarter inch ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ). No J-bolts, bolts, chains, etc., from frame to hood. Hoods must have a six inch by six inch (6" x 6") hole for safety. Maximum of four (4) chains.
11. Bumpers must be Original Equipment of Manufacturer (OEM). Stock brackets may be welded to bumper and frame. No braces may be welded or added to bumper and bumper cannot be welded to body. Tips and fender wells can be trimmed. No reinforcing. The official's decision will be final.
12. No station wagon deck lids allowed.
13. Seat belts with the shoulder harness must be securely fastened and worn at all times. If not currently existing, a shoulder harness (at least one crossing shoulder) will be added to the lap belt requirement for seat belts. The minimum seat belt configuration will be one (1) lap belt and one (1) crossing shoulder harness.
14. Batteries must be securely bolted or chained in place (plumber's tape is not considered adequate as a securing device.)
15. The battery should be located, as it always has, in the driver's compartment and shall be securely covered by a flame-resistant material (split piece of inner tube) in order to stop any acid splash or any sparks connecting with the gas – which is also kept in the passenger compartment.
16. Stock gas tanks must be removed.
17. The temporary gas tank must be placed forward of the rear axle and may contain a maximum of six (6) gallons of gas. Temporary gas tanks must be metal (no plastic allowed).
18. Only stock fuel pumps will be allowed. No electric fuel pumps.

19. Radiator must be stock automobile and in original stock position. No additional radiator supports or mounts. Firewall must be stock with no large holes. No radiator water inside of car.
20. No reinforcing will be allowed except on the driver's door.
21. No tire chains, spikes, studs or dual tires will be allowed.
22. Body-to-frame hardware and bushings must be OEM stock. Frames must be in OEM condition on any/all vehicles.
23. Car number must be placed on the top (not hood or trunk) and on both doors of the car. All car numbers and letters must be at least eighteen inches (18") high and one and one half (1½") wide. **Driver door must be painted white. MANDATORY** All cars, drivers, pit crew members and support vehicles must be numbered with derby car number issued on the entry blank. All cars must have the number visible on the top of the car, a minimum of 18" x 24" in size. The driver and crew members must have the car's number on their shirt.
24. Driver's safety cage – a rectangle of two inch (2") hollow tubing from driver's door to passenger door in front of and behind driver attaching to six inch by six inch (6" x 6") support plates on each door may be constructed to create a driver's safety cage. Two (2) cross bars of two inch (2") hollow tubing may be welded to connect the tubing in front of and behind the driver – one (1) cross bar located to the left of the driver and one (1) cross bar located to the right of the driver. The tubing used for the driver's safety cage shall not exceed two inch (2") . The cross bars shall be made with hollow tubing that shall be two inch (2") . The right cross bar must be located no more than twelve inches (12") from the passenger door to the right of the driver. A maximum of eight inch (8") channel metal. No down bars and no kickers.
25. Bumper height may not exceed twenty inches (20") from the ground to the bottom of the bumper. Bumper height will be measured by officials and the car must push. No coil leaf conversions. Only stock automobile springs. No extra leafs. No tape. No welding on springs. No coils over shocks. OEM shackles only. No clamps will be allowed. Twisties are permitted.
26. In most vehicles there are a series of knock-out plugs in the floorboards. These shall be removed so that any gas spilled in the passenger compartment will drain out through the floor of the car. If there are not any knock-outs in the floor, a minimum of six (6) holes shall be drilled in the area of the gas tank.
27. A maximum of three (3) #4 rebar (or equal or better) may be used vertically across the front windshield as protection for the driver against flying objects.
28. Each car must have a minimum of front brakes in good working order. This will be checked and enforced during inspection. Cars not meeting requirement will be disqualified.
29. Obvious teaming-up between two (2) or more cars is grounds for immediate disqualification of vehicles involved. This will be a judgment call from the judges in the arena and in the tower. Judges decision will be final.
30. Vehicles disqualified from heats or main event may still be used in the Powder Puff event.
31. In the event of an emergency or any situation requiring the stopping of action in the arena, a horn will sound at which time all cars must come to a complete stop. No driver is to leave the car or unfasten the seat belt until the heat is finished except in the case of fire. Failure to comply with this rule will result in immediate disqualification from the event and from participation in derby events for one (1) year.
32. Any car with more than two (2) car fires will be disqualified. Car will be disqualified on second fire.
33. After an official time-out, all cars not previously disqualified will have two (2) minutes to get started and make contact with another vehicle under its own power.
34. Any car not contacting another car, under it's own power, after a two (2) minute period will be disqualified.

35. Any driver contacting another car's driver door will be disqualified. Cars disqualified for infractions of this rule shall be disqualified for the remainder of this year's derby. A disqualified driver of a derby car may allow the car to be used in the Powder Puff.
36. Full face helmets only may be used and long sleeved shirts are required.
37. All cars left unattended on fairground will be at the driver's risk
38. Any derby official has final decision on any and all questions and disputes. All decisions of the officials will be final.
39. If after inspections are made and a car is passed any illegal changes will result in immediate disqualification, no exceptions.

## Fair Rules & Regulations

1. All entry blanks must be filled in completely and accompanied with the specified entry fee. Checks should be made out to the 39th DAA. In order to secure a number, entrants may return entry form without the fee, however it will be considered an entry pending and must be paid in full by May 1.
2. Derby rules and fair rules must be accepted with signature and returned with entry form. Release and waiver of liability agreement must also be signed and returned with entry form.
3. There will be a maximum of 40 paid entries permitted in the Derby and 20 paid entries permitted in the Powder Puff.
4. Entries and drivers are limited to legal residents of Alpine, Amador, Calaveras & Tuolumne Counties. Drivers must be sixteen (16) years of age or older, have a valid driver's license and sign the application stating such. Drivers under age eighteen (18) must have signed parental consent forms.
5. Entry Fee for each driver are: Main Event - \$75.00 Powder Puff - \$25.00
6. There will be no more than four (4) elimination heats and one Mulligan.
7. The main event will consist of three (3) top vehicles from the elimination heats. Official may add fourth car if needed. Fifth (5th) place heat qualifiers will be on standby in the event that any qualified car is unable to participate.
8. Heat positions/car selections will be done by random draw on the closing date.
9. Prize money and trophies will be awarded to first (1st) through third (3rd) place in the main event and the powder puff. A \$100.00 prize and trophies will be awarded to first (1st) place winners in elimination heats. There will not be trophies awarded for the Mulligan.
10. Trophies will be awarded for Best of Show in the Main Event and Powder Puff. A trophy will also be awarded for the prettiest car. These awards will be decided by audience applause.
11. All money will be awarded after the close of the fair. Trophies will be awarded at the end of each heat and after the Main Event.
12. Calaveras County Fairground is public property. "Driving under the influence" arrests can and will be made if persons are operating any vehicle under the influence of alcohol or non-prescription drugs. No drinking of alcohol or non-alcoholic beer is permitted in the pit areas.
13. There will be a maximum of five (5) pit passes available for each entry. One (1) for the driver and two (2) for crew members will come with the entry fees. Two (2) more passes may be purchased for \$15.00 each. All liability forms must be signed.
14. Drivers will be allowed to enter only one division, either Main or Powder Puff, not both.

## Driver & Pit Crew Rules & Regulations

1. There will be no alcoholic beverages or use of non-prescription drugs allowed in the pits or the immediate surrounding area. **Drivers and pit crew members shall not drink before or during the event. No O'Douls or non-alcoholic brews will be allowed in the pits.**
2. Violation of any of the rules or lack of cooperation with fair staff or derby officials by any driver or pit crew member will result in immediate disqualification, forfeiture of entry fees and disqualification from derby events for one (1) year.
3. Vehicle inspection will begin at 11:00 a.m. on the day of the event in the pit area. Inspection will end at 3:00 p.m. No vehicles will be allowed in the pit after inspection has ended. A drivers meeting will be held approximately 4:00 p.m.

4. All cars, drivers, pit crew members and support vehicles must be numbered with derby car number issued on the entry blank. All cars must have it's number visible on the top of the car, a minimum of 18" x 24" in size. The driver and crew members must have the car's number on their shirt.
5. Only those possessing a valid gate pass worn around the wrist (wristband) will be allowed in the pit area. This includes one (1) driver and up to two (2) crew members per entry. No vehicle except the entry car and one support vehicle will be allowed in the pit area. Absolutely no exceptions. Two (2) additional pit passes can be purchased for \$15.00 with a completed & signed release of liability form.
6. Driver and pit crew members for each entry shall, at all times, wear the assigned vehicle number on their back and the number(s) must be at least eight inches (8") high. No tape permitted.
7. Only car, driver, pit crew members and support vehicle properly identified will be permitted to enter the pit area. No one under sixteen (16) years of age will be allowed in the pit area. Anyone under age eighteen (18) must have signed parental consent forms.
8. All wording on the vehicles and team shirts **must be in good taste.**
9. Drivers must provide proof of age and residence. All drivers must be present at car during inspection and will produce their helmet at that time. Driver's licenses will be checked by clerical staff when you pick up wristbands.
10. All cars scheduled for each event must enter the arena when the event is called, including the Powder Puff event. A maximum of two minutes will be allowed between each car entering the arena.
11. The finals will be held fifteen (15) minutes after the last car has been removed from the arena following the Mulligan.
12. No driver or car substitutions will be permitted in the Mulligan or the Main Event. Car and driver are a "Team" throughout the derby. Exception: Powder Puff driver can be in any car of her choosing – no restrictions.
13. No vehicle, except those of **Sam Berri Towing or is designated representative**, will be allowed in the arena between events.
14. A helmet must be worn (strapped on) during the derby/powder puff. Drivers should refrain from wearing clothing made of synthetic material (ie – nylon, rayon, etc.) Drivers must wear long sleeved shirts during the event.
- 15. NEW in the event of any medical emergency and or fire hazard only qualified medical and fire personnel will be permitted in the Arena. Specifically no pit crews or derby officials are to intervene. Let the professionals do their job!**

### Attention: Calaveras County Destruction Derby Participants

The Calaveras County Abandoned Vehicle Abatement program can remove, at minimal cost, your derby car if it is unwanted after this event.

Several things are required prior to removal:

1. A request form must be filled out, signed, and returned to the Abandoned Vehicle Abatement office by May 1, 2007.
2. The pink slip or junk slip *must* be attached.
3. The vehicle must be accessible to our tow provider.
4. All related parts should be put inside the vehicle.
5. Payment of \$65 must also be included with the request.

**DO NOT** take your cars onto public property to dump pursuant to Vehicle Code §22669 and Calaveras County Code §10.26.010. Dumping can result in a citation being issued for a Public Nuisance and you can be billed for the cost of towing.

Please contact us if we can assist you in disposal of your vehicle.

### Attention: City of Angels Residents

The party responsible for the registration of Destruction Derby vehicles shall remove the vehicle and all related parts from public view within the City of Angels city limits within 7 days of the Destruction Derby.

Failure to comply may result in a citation for Public Nuisance.
