- Wine must be produced from grapes grown, or winery must be located in, one of the following counties: Alpine, Amador, Calaveras, El Dorado, Mariposa, Nevada, Placer, Sierra or Tuolumne.
- Wines are to be bottled under bond by a commercial winery and must be commercially labeled.
- For varietals, grape type must be clearly stated on label.
- Finished products only, no barrels.
- Please submit **three** bottles per entry.
- Bottle size (1) 750ml or (2) 375ml
